Bylaws Revision Proposal

Option Analysis and Recommendation for COC

Matthew K & Evan S-O 2/4/2023

Background

- State the Issues Bylaws are no longer fully reflective of current lodge practices and have not be looked at in a few years
- State the Impact Causes parts to be out of date

Problem Statement

 What is the Problem Statement- Bylaws currently to not reflect fully how the lodge is operating and not aligned with the national standards

- 1. Changes to Article 5 (V) regarding the removal of Lodge Officers.
 - a. Mostly a reshuffling to clarify contradictions within the section.

Proposed Bylaws

- Changes to Article 7 (VII) regarding the Lodge Executive Council and Article 8 (VIII) regarding the Lodge Council of Chiefs.
 - a. Changes Include:
 - i. A merge of Articles 7 (VII) and 8 (VIII) to have one governing body to be known as the Lodge Executive Committee
 - Standardized with the rest of the Order of the Arrow

- i. Changes to Articles 2 (II), 4 (IV), 5 (V), 7 (VII), 8 (VIII), 9 (IX), 10 (X), 11 (XI), 12 (XII), 13 (XIII)
 - 1. Changes Include:
 - a. Renaming of both the Lodge Executive Council and the Council of Chiefs throughout Articles 2 (II) through Articles 13 (XIII) to the Lodge Executive Committee to reflect the newly merged Lodge legislative body and changes to Order of the Arrow Terminology.
 - b. The Removal of Article 7 (VII) regarding the Lodge Executive Council
 - c. The Renaming of Articles 8 (VIII) through 13 (XIII) to reflect their new order following the aforementioned removal of Article 7 (VII).

- 3. Changes to Article 10 (X) regarding the Trading Post
 - a. Changes Include:
 - i. Removal of the Lodge Vice Chief of Trading post, who is never mentioned anywhere else in the By-Laws
- 4. Changes to Article 11 (XI) regarding Lodge Publication
 - a. Changes include:
 - i. A re-ordering of clauses to improve clarification and understanding.



Operation Arrow 2023


Operation Arrow is an opportunity to experience the 2023 National Jamboree while providing service with your fellow Arrowmen.
